

An Amazing Moment

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Tools and Products Required:

2 x White CS (Background)
3 x Patterned Papers

Chipboard Mannequin, Birdcage and wings

How to Complete your layout step by step

1. Mist your background pages with the Glimmer mist and allow to dry
2. Using your G45 Peek-a-Boo paper, cut two strips of 1cm x 30cm and two strips 3cm x 30cm
3. Using your G45 Cherished paper, cut two strips 11cm x 30cm
4. From your G45 Primrose Cottage Paper (flowers) cut two strips of 4cm x 30cm
5. Chalk everything if you want to (if you are a chalker, chalk all elements on this layout)
6. Adhere as shown to your background papers
7. Stamp image on left page under the Primrose Cottage paper, about 9-10cm from the left side
8. Adhere your Peach scallop border strips as per the layout
9. Using Your Vintage Photo Distress Ink, Colour your netting on your craft sheet
10. Cut your netting into at least 9 strips
11. Dress your mannequin as desired with the elements provided in your kit.
12. Cover your Fabscraps Chipboard corners with Coffee Archival Ink and Clear Heat Emboss
13. Trace your tag onto your cream cardstock and cut 7 tags
14. Glue your olive green re-inforcers to the holes
15. Tie your netting through the tags for effect
16. Arrange your tags with the letters spelling 'Amazing'
17. Raise the tags by cutting pieces of the provided white chipboard and gluing it to the tags
18. Glue the title down as per the picture, or wait until you have added the photos after step 25
19. Glue the hinges to the layout as shown
20. Adhere the brads to the hinges
21. Fuzzy cut some flowers from the left over Primrose Cottage paper
22. Stamp the round tag in the kit and chalk/distress if desired
23. Tie a piece of netting to it
24. Matt/Mount your photos as desired
25. Glue your photos down
26. Now you can add all the elements as per the layout
27. Glue your butterflies where desired and add some stickles for dimension
28. Cover your title with a layer of Glossy Accents and leave to dry
29. Use pearls/diamante to finish off the layout

NOTES: It is really important to use a very good glue when you are going to add Glossy Accents to any paper. Leave Glossy Accents to dry properly before placing the layout in an album. When covering Chipboard with any ink before Heat Embossing, make sure the ink is completely dry before inking it with your clear embossing pad, or adding clear embossing powder. Your Clear Embossing pad/Clear Embossing powder will stain if the ink is still wet
